## Safety Rules for Exhibitors

## Dear Exhibitor:

Thank you for attending Yankee Steam-Up. Your exhibit helps make the show.

Safety and safe operation of machinery are your responsibility. If you have concerns, please bring them to the attention of any museum staff member. We appreciate your help and cooperation.

- 1. Machinery that is running *cannot* be left unattended. This rule must be followed. If an engine is observed running and unattended a Safety Officer will shut it down and notify the exhibitor. On a second offense we will require the exhibitor to refrain from operation for the rest of the show.
- 2. Any exhibit containing internal or external combustion must have a fire extinguisher. Fire extinguishers should be where they can be easily seen and reached. Extinguishers should be large enough and rated to be effective on a gas or oil fire (around 8 lb. with a rating of A-B-C).
- 3. Exhibitors are to be at least 18 years of age unless supervised by an adult.
- 4. No bare feet on the show grounds.
- 5. No open alcohol on the grounds (per state law).
- No animals except service animals.
- 7. All boiler and pressure vessels must be equipped with all state-required safety and protection devices, including but not limited to pressure relief valves, and must have been hydro-tested within the last 12 months.
